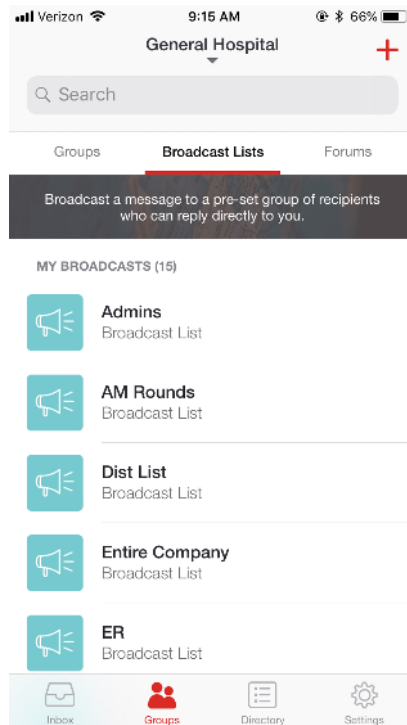

Collaborative Messaging

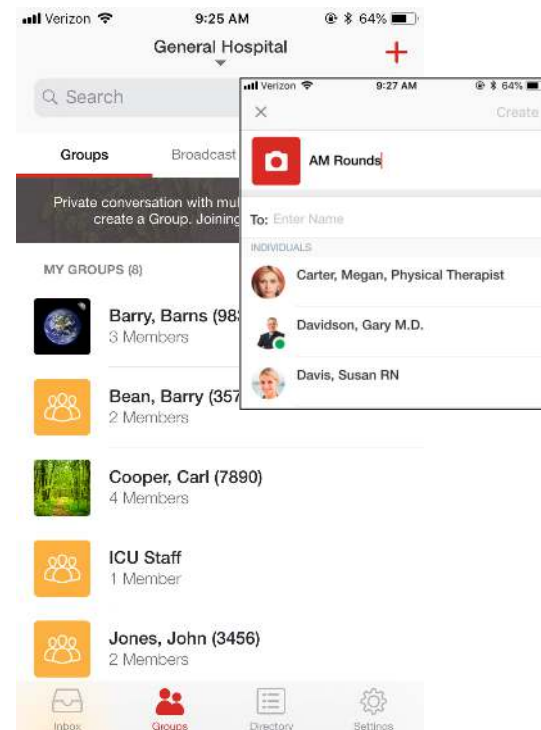
TigerConnect's Broadcast List and Groups features gives your teams a few options for a fast and easy way to share real-time information about patients, making it easier to coordinate care efforts, share results, and facilitate patient handoffs. Groups lets users quickly assemble a team of physicians, nurses, and support staff by name or by role around a patient, a department, or a particular topic. Broadcast Lists allow you to send a quick message to users, allowing the recipient to respond only to the sender.

Broadcast Lists

Broadcast lists are created by TigerConnect Administrators. Anyone can send a message to a Broadcast List. The users on the list are not shown in the application. Messages sent to Broadcast Lists will send to all users and responses are only received by the sender of the Broadcast message. Brackets show the name of the list.

Groups

Groups can be created by anyone on TigerConnect. Only users included in the group can send or view messages. All messages are shared with members of group, making a collaborative conversation. Groups are private and cannot be viewed by any user not included in the group.
